- needs lots of assistance with the ability to do rolling from back to stomach, pulling himself to standing from a sitting position, going upstairs in any house or building, going down stairs in any house or building, picking up small objects such as a cheerio, transferring an object from hand to hand, crawling, creeping, or scooting, such as getting something from under the bed or chair, sitting without support for at least 5 minutes, such as piano bench or stool without a back, does not walk independently uses a wheelchair
- needs assistance with events & actions, knows daily routine, such as what occurs in the morning, afternoon & evening
- needs assistance with perceptual abilities with finding his way around the house
- e needs assistance with number awareness, can't do simple addition without use of calculator or computer
- needs assistance with expressive verbal communication when using complete sentences
- needs assistance with expressive verbal communication when telling a simple story, such as about a television show
- tends to look away when others look at him, finds himself uncomfortable being apart of a group, keeps being sad & enjoyment to himself, have difficulty telling others when he is upset



- needs lots of assistance with moving around in familiar settings, such as home, washing face, brushing & combing hair, tying laces or fastening velcro on own shoes
- has not done making his bed, cleaning his room, doing his laundry, caring for his own clothes such as folding or putting them away, using public transportation for simple direct trip other than ACCESS link or other medical transports, choosing food when shopping for a simple meal, preparing foods that do not require cooking, such as a sandwich or cereal, using the stove, microwave, washing dishes or dishwasher, ordering food in public, choosing items he wants to buy, using money such as handing it to cashier, making small routine purchases, making or counting change
